The Northwest Region of Association of Alberta Agricultural Fieldmen (AAAF) Planning Committee has been working diligently to plan a safe and welcoming Provincial Agricultural Service Board (ASB) Conference.

Our conference will be following the guidance of the Government of Alberta's [Restriction Exemption Program](#) with several rules that need to be followed to ensure the event is safe for all. In addition, the Westin Hotel follows [Committed to Clean procedures](#). Further, the Planning Committee has been in contact with Alberta Health Services and worked to incorporate their guidance.

What we are doing:

- Onsite COVID-19 rapid testing will be available in the Viking Room for a \$20 fee per test
 - Tuesday Jan 25, 5-8 pm
 - Wednesday, Jan 26, 6-9 am
- Each participant will be required to have a visible wristband to acknowledge that they have provided proof of vaccination or an acceptable negative test, as per REP. Wristband stations will be set up at the top of the escalators
 - Tuesday Jan 25, 5-8 pm
 - Wednesday Jan 26, 6-9 am
- Hand sanitizer at each table
- Reduction of high traffic opportunities through plated lunches and banquet
- Sanitation of voting devices between use

In order for our event to proceed safely, we will rely on each of our participants to also contribute.

- Wear a mask at all times when not eating. Consider a well-fitting medical mask or an N95 mask
- Maintain physical distancing, wherever possible
- Sitting with your cohorts at tables for the day
- If you are feeling unwell at all, please stay home

We will be doing everything we can to ensure that the spirit of community and advocacy of this Conference continues to be our goal, along with the more urgent need of keeping our participants safe.
